



## Here is a list of supplies we suggest you bring

- Sewing machine with module, power cord, embroidery foot, straight stitch plate (preferable if you own one), embroidery needles
- Hoops with the corresponding grids. Chalk or transfer pens to mark fabric center lines.
- Small applique iron, if your project includes applique pieces.
- Stabilizer for hooping. If you are unsure of type we can help!
- 505 Adhesive spray, fabric glue stick
- Thread: Polyester 40 wt. such as Isacord or Mettler – Lots of colors depending on your chosen pattern and then some!
- Scissors: Applique for trimming fabric around designs. Preferably curved blades and a bend in handles.
- USB stick with design loaded. We will help download if you are unsure how.
- *Print out directions for you project prior to coming. Read all the way through, get familiar!*
- A small side table for extra room. A TV tray is a great size. There is not room for a table much larger than that. Not a must but it might be good to steady a hoop while trimming appliques.
- Drink glasses or bottles must have a lid. We do supply bottled water.

**Mark or label all your items with your name/initials. Hoops, grids, stabilizer, spray adhesive...etc.**

We recommend no matter which project you are working on to come prepared with some of your block backgrounds or stabilizer already cut. We can then focus on hooping and embroidery techniques more than cutting.
