

# RULER PLAY FEATHER PROJECT

## 14" X 37" Table Runner

### Supply List:

#### Fabric/Batting/Thread:

Three 10" squares batik or other tone-on tone fabric  
½ yard for sashings, border and binding  
17"x40" batting of choice  
17"x40" fabric for quilt backing

Neutral thread for piecing  
50 wt. cotton thread in the bobbin for quilting  
40 wt. polyester embroidery thread in top of machine for quilting

Microtex sharp needle 80/12 for piecing  
Jeans/Denim needle or Topstitch 90/14 for quilting

#### Westalee Rulers:

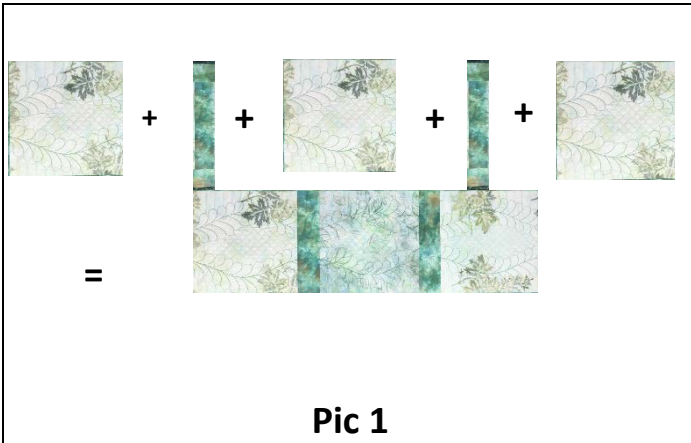
10" feather spine  
3" feather template  
8X2 straight ruler with 45 degree markings  
Spacing gauge  
Optional: Stitching Line Discs

#### Notions:

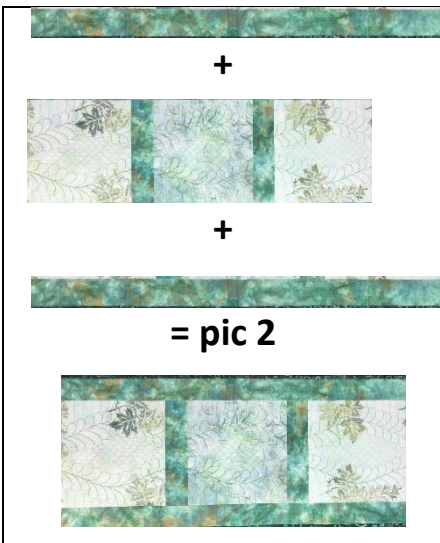
Rotary cutting equipment – mat, rulers, cutter  
Straight pins  
Water soluble marker, such as MarkBGone

**Piecing:**

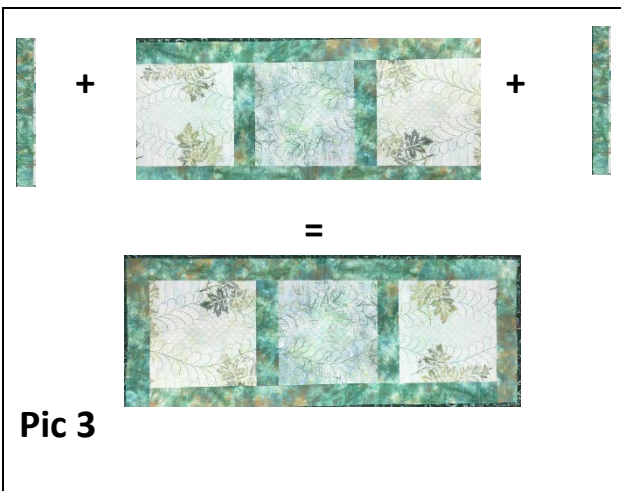
- 1) From ½ yard sashing/border/binding fabric, cut four 2-1/2" strips. Set remainder aside for binding.



- 2) From one of the strips, cut two 2-1/2" x 10" rectangles. Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew one rectangle to the bottom of each of two of the 10" squares, then sew the three squares together. Press toward darker fabric.



- 3) Measure length of runner; should be 33". Cut two strips to the length of your measurement. Sew them to both long sides of the runner and press toward border.(Pic.2)



- 4) Measure width of runner through the center; should be 14". Cut two strips to the length of your measurement. Sew them to both ends of the runner and press toward border (Pic. 3)
